Brunel in Teignbridge

Unique events in Teignbridge for Brunel200 include an operating model of the atmospheric railway, a community play celebrating railways in Newton Abbot and FREE vintage bus rides between museums.

Dawlish will be the site of new **Brunel interpretation boards** so look out for these while walking the coastal path over the summer. The 160th anniversary of the first passenger train at Dawlish Station will take place on the afternoon of **30 May 2006**.

Phil Smith will be leading **walks** around the route of Brunel's Atmospheric Railway, searching out traces of that pioneering and fated project and the atmospheres of contemporary Teignbridge.

Two walks open to all:

- 10am on **Sunday 14 May** from Old Forde House
- 10am on **Tuesday 13 June** from Teignmouth Museum

The walks are gentle, but will last between 3 and 4 hours.
